**Exercise Objectives:**

- Orient with mutual aid departments' equipment
- Perform trench rescue (characteristics below)
  - Provide for responder safety
  - Remove victims
- Utilize proper ICS (Springdale FD AHJ)
  - Emphasis on structure (groups) and chain of command with multiple depts.
  - Structure functional assignments to incident needs and elimination of duplication

**Trench Characteristics:**

Approximately 16' L x 8' D

Utility (water) located within

Lip failure (1 side) with two victims present – conscious and unable to self-extricate

1 victim in sitting position with soil covering lower extremities

1 victim in supine position with soil covering lower extremities, pelvis, and abdomen

**Exercise Timeline:**

0900 Deploy to exercise site in Springdale

0930 Orient with other department's equipment

1030 Begin scenario

1200 End scenario and stow equipment

1230 Return
